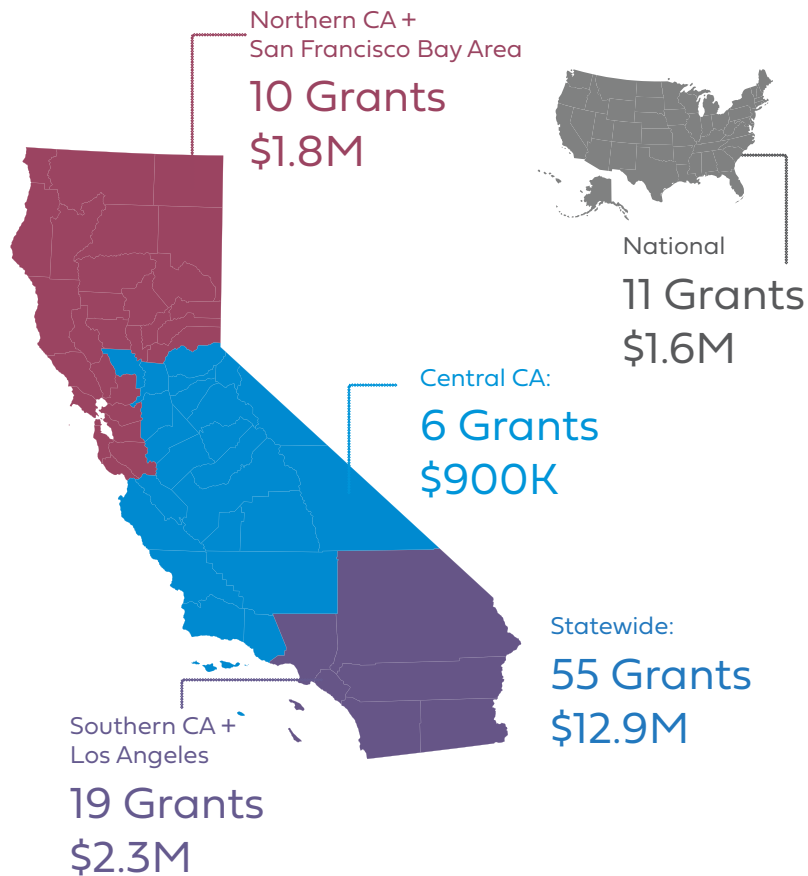

## Our strategy

We believe that domestic violence and health inequities are caused by deep-rooted, systemic issues—namely gender and economic inequity, and racism. As a statewide funder, our strategy leverages policy and systems change to address those root causes.

We seek to improve the lives of the Californians most affected by domestic violence and health inequities: people of color in communities with low incomes.

## Our approaches

### Strengthen economic security and mobility

Health and well-being for Californians are inextricably connected to their economic security. When families are economically secure, they can meet their basic needs. This leads to healthier individuals, families, and communities, and can prevent violence in the home.

### Align systems with community priorities

Communities understand their needs and strengths best. The most effective way to build lasting, equitable solutions to health disparities is by empowering communities, aligning systems with their priorities, and emphasizing health equity.

### Break the cycle of domestic violence

Ending domestic violence requires working across generations to prevent childhood exposure, while also strengthening prevention and healing. To break this multigenerational cycle, we focus on directly addressing its root causes.
